5 Takami Shrine

Takami Shrine was built in 1682. Japanese traditional "Kagura" (Ritual ceremonial dance of Shinto) is shown at the Autumn festival every year. Kagura in this shrine is called "Goten Kagura."



2 Jujika-no Tou (Cross Monuments)

A memorial cenotaph for prisoners of war built after World War II. It is the symbol of peace in Mizumaki. You can access it about a 5-minute walk from Mizumaki Town Public Library.

6 Yatsurugi Shrine

One of Japan's biggest ginko tree is in this shrine. This 1900-year-old tree has a trunk circumference of approx. 9.7m, and has been designated as a natural monument of Fukuoka prefecture. The ginko tree is also designated as Mizumaki's town tree.
